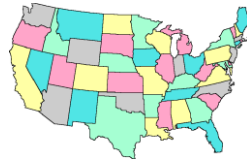

Whither We Goest, Thou Goest: By Your Prayers And Financial Support



Greetings from humid Natchez, MS. We are still having a lot of rainy days. We have been knocking in a more populated area as of recent days. We still have two sections to complete that are near the church building that is more scattered.

The preacher here, Ronnie Cosby, will be leaving March 22nd. He has had bad health for some time and told me when we first got here that he didn't know how much longer he could work with the church. He and his wife are moving to Kentucky to be near their daughter. He plans to preach when he can and to teach as needed. Please remember them in your prayers as they make this move.

The men asked me **to preach and teach** when Ronnie leaves. Unfortunately, we will only be here a couple of weeks after he leaves before we leave to go to our next work. Please remember the church here in your prayers as they look for a preacher that they find a sound man.

Ronnie started handling **the Bible Correspondence Course (BCC) we signed up**, but now has given it up. Sunday evening before services I presented the program to those interested in helping with the BCCs. Several have shown an interest so I went over a few things about handling the BCCs. We met again Wednesday night with two members (some interested were not able to be there) and we got the lessons out which Sandy and I signed up the days before and graded the ones which came in. I have also suggested that the church do the BCC lessons in a Bible class so they will know what's in the studies when they talk to their friends about them. I am trying to encourage them to keep on with the BCCs after we leave here and have also offered to help (via email anyway that we can, such as answering the students questions, making certificates, etc.) even though we will not be here. I believe several are enthused enough to keep it going. So far we have **signed up 40 for the Hurt BCC here**.

There are four taking my BCC now. One person wrote that he has always been able to understand most of what is written in God's Holy Word, **but this course has really opened his eyes, so to speak!** I hope and pray that it will continue to open his eyes to the truth. Two of these students I have already put on the Hurt course and all that finish my BCC I will put on the Hurt course. I full well believe that anyone who has an honest heart and is seeking the truth on salvation can find it by doing these Bible lessons. All I have done is write down the Scripture and then ask questions concerning them. Just Bible, nothing that I've come up with except the questions! This is the BCC that is put into each packet that we hand out.

I have been dealing with a Catholic priest some from South Dakota. Last summer, while at the county airport with a member of the church I gave this person a packet of material. Later he sent me a post card stating he would like to correspond. So I sent him a letter and also a study on the church in order to get a study going. Later he sent me another post card stating he would like to begin with the canon. I briefly stated my position on why I use the KJV and other things he asked about. He emailed and asked about 4 questions to which I replied and then I asked him the same questions. I also sent a short study concerning Peter and the rock and another one on the Catholic Church. The bottom line is: the Catholic priest answered not a thing; neither did he state his position on anything; nor did he answer his own questions when I turned them on him. I pointed this out to him and also challenged him to a debate at his place of "worship" concerning the church. It is pitiful!

We pray God's many blessings on all of you as you continue to serve Him faithfully. Sandy and I are very grateful to all of you who support us and the work. It humbles us to know that you have such confidence in us.
