She asked where he was but got no reply. She stepped inside to **find the man lying on the floor**. She told him that she would get help and about that time, I came to the door. I went inside and after questioning him to make sure he hadn't had a stroke or something like that, I helped him to his chair. He could hardly move his legs. I sent Melba to the office to get them to come and they called an ambulance. It was fortunate for that man that we came along or else he may have lain on the floor for a long time.

We **knocked** on a young woman's door the other day and she was so glad we came by that she gave Sandy a new cookbook. We tried to refuse it, but she insisted. While talking to her, she burst into tears and started telling us some of her life. We encouraged her to straighten out her life by studying the Bible and being obedient to it. **As we walked away, Sandy said that it reminded her of the woman who washed Jesus' feet with her tears. I said it reminded me of the song, "Bring Christ Your Broken Heart."** Since Ronnie has left and since we are leaving too, Sandy and I met with the preacher at the black congregation not far from where she lives. The preacher assured us that he would visit with her. She is taking the Bible correspondence course and we hope will visit with the church. You meet all kinds of people while door knocking. On our last day out, we ran across a man who said, "I am trying to live the best I know how." But he refused to take the Bible correspondence course. It is sad how many are relying on "the best **I** know" but do not care what God has to say on how we are to live.
