We would like to be able to leave the material at the houses where no one is home since we walk the same distance and sweat the same amount, but unfortunately we can only give material to those who answer the door and accept it. Sandy is still having sinus trouble and she thinks it is all the dryness and dust out here.

**We have some who seem to really appreciate us coming by.** The other day we met a young lady who told us that she wanted some information on the church of Christ. Hopefully she will study the material and have an honest desire to learn more. We talked with a man who said I was the first "man of God" he has ever heard say that I didn't know everything. Sandy and I talked with him for a long time answering some of the questions he had. We had scheduled a study with 2 Mormon "elders" but they called and cancelled, as we figured they might. But refreshingly, this past Sunday we had a visitor from the community. One of the members here, Paul, was cleaning her carpet and started talking religion with her. When she found out he was a member of the church she said she had a packet of material from us. I think this is why it is so important that we all invite people. She said she would be back.

**There is a young couple here who was recently converted** who had been raised in the Jehovah Witness. They seem to be a great asset to the church here. They were baptized in November of last year and Paul (mentioned above) gave his first lesson a couple of weeks ago. He did a very good job. He also leads singing and does a good job at that. Paul said that what made him change his life around was when he looked into the innocent eyes of his two young daughters and realized he and his wife weren't bringing them up right. He got on the internet and found a brotherhood website and studied it diligently, then sought out the church here. I believe Matt. 7:7 says it all, when an honest heart is seeking, he will find the truth. As I have stated many times, we are praying for those "honest hearts" each time we pass out a packet of the material. There are two sisters here, Pauline age 96 {will be 97 in July} and her sister, Myrl, who is 93. Myrl lives with Pauline to take care of her. Pauline was at the shop getting her nails done when Sandy called to make the appointment. From what we have seen they exemplify true Christian attitudes not only in their faithful attendance, but in their everyday lives. We will surely miss them when we leave here.

**I preach every other Sunday and have taught some.** I have also been very busy answering various ones (some here) via email. Dave also asked me to help with a marriage seminar which we did at the end of May. He tries to reach out to the community in several ways, this being one of them. We greatly appreciate Dave with his evangelistic attitude. It is refreshing to find one who is busy doing what he can to reach the lost.
