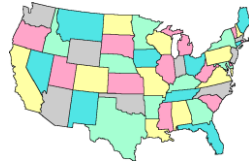

Whither We Goest, Thou Goest: By Your Prayers And Financial Support



Greetings from the travelers on our way to WA. We have had a very good trip so far and have seen some beautiful new country. We had a passenger with us for over 600 miles of our trip: Our younger daughter, Amy, flew out here the 25th of July for a visit. Peter Ray left for India on the 22nd. She traveled with us as far as Salt Lake City, UT where she took a plane back home. We had looked forward to her trip for so long and now that her visit is over it seems almost like a dream. It is hard to be so far away from our children and grandchildren.

Our 40th wedding anniversary is coming up October the 5th, so we thought we would take the opportunity while we are traveling this way to take a little more time and see some sights on the way since we may never see this part of the world again. This also gives us more opportunities to visit with the church along the way. Much preparation and planning goes into our travels, especially when we are traveling so far. First, we plan our trip so we will be in an area where the church is so we can meet with them. After we left Winslow, July 29th, we were at **Moab, Utah** on Wednesday evening and met with the church there. They are without a preacher so they asked me to speak. This congregation had about a dozen present. On Sunday, we traveled on to **Brigham City** where I spoke for all three services. They, too, are without a preacher and had about 12 also. Many made good comments after the lessons and some wished we could stay. **Both congregations have nice buildings, but both need a good sound preacher, so if you know of any preachers looking let them know about these congregations.**

Our trip to, and work at Winslow was quite expensive on us: Our travel out there; travel to door knock (see totals below); camping space (higher than normal), etc. We pay for all of this from our salary: even when members give us money to help on our personal expenses we put it in the general fund for material and salary, so we are truly on a limited income. We knew before we went there that the church at Winslow would not be able to help with packets of material or any other expenses. Dave told us when we got there that several other people had wanted to come and help the church but when they found out the church could not help with their finances, they would not come. He said we were the only ones who had been willing to come {see letter on back}. This is another reason we appreciate all of you who help us financially in this work. Our last Sunday at Winslow was sad. I spoke that morning and several folks told us how they wished we could stay. We will greatly miss many of the folks there. It was a sad evening for us when we said our good-byes. Dave emailed us the other day and said one of the ladies that he had studied with, and had been coming due to our door knocking efforts, was **baptized**.

It is hard for us to put into words how much we **appreciate** those of you who **support** us and the work financially, and those of you who **pray** for us. I know each month we tell you so, but it doesn't seem enough. We realize that without you, we would not be doing what we are. It is a small thing we do, just planting the seed, but we also realize that someone needs to be doing the planting and we feel privileged to be able to do so. Please pray for those who will go and water, and we all must remember it is God who gives the increase.
