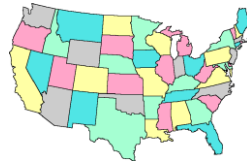

Whither We Goest, Thou Goest: By Your Prayers And Financial Support



Greetings to you all. We hope that each and every one of you are enjoying good health. We are doing fine and looking forward to spring time and warmer weather.

We passed out a total of 509 packets of material at Centre, AL and some members kept 40 packets to pass out in their communities. After we finished our work in Centre, AL, we came to TN for a few weeks before going to Louisville, MS for more door knocking and the gospel meeting. While in TN, we are passing out packets of material for a small congregation (made up mostly of elderly) about an hour from Tammy's. They are having a gospel meeting in April so we are putting their advertisement in the packets as well. We have enjoyed working with, and worshipping with these congregations: Centre made us feel so welcome and the preacher there brought very good lessons; we have felt at home in the small congregation here in TN and enjoying more good lessons. I have preached twice here. We certainly look forward to being with the Louisville congregation again and hearing more good sermons from the preacher there. We are also looking forward to meeting our new brother in Christ at Louisville as a result partly from our prior work there.

While in TN, I am doing some motorhome maintenance: changing the oil, etc. We also built a small storage building to keep some things in. We have a few boxes in Tammy's and Michael's garage, but they are pretty crowded and we do not want to be a burden to anyone. The building will give us space to keep a few tools I do not want to carry with us all the time, but will be useful in servicing the motorhome. The motorhome is about 7 years old and some major expenses are coming up such as replacing the tires and batteries. Most recommend replacing the tires every 7 years, ours says 7 to 10 years depending on how they look. I am going to try for 10, but this is something one does not want to be careless in, if a tire blows it normally causes extensive damage to the motorhome and there is also the possibility of a wreck which would be even worse.

Some from the East Main congregation, Tupelo, will be coming to help us door knock before the meeting at Louisville. We are looking forward to being with these brothers and sisters and getting to know them better. We greatly appreciate their help in this effort. Being in the family of God is such a blessing. I am reminded often of the passage which says "... There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the kingdom of God's sake, Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting" (Luke 18:30). Unfortunately people of the world do not understand this. I remember Sandy's sister remarking years ago about us leaving our family in Virginia and going to Memphis to preaching school. She just couldn't understand that when you are a child of God, you have family any place where the church of Christ exists.

In place of the bulletin this month, I am sending a copy of the two tracts that I recently had printed. If any of you would like to have more, just let me know and I will be glad to send them to you. The "Heaven or Hell" tract is the quality of tracts we will print in the future. I found a place on the internet to order them and the quality is much better than the "Thief" tract and the price is not much more expensive. As I stated last month, we can save much if we order in large quantities.

We pray God's many blessings on each of you as you continue to serve Him faithfully. We thank you very much for your financial support, your prayers and your desire to reach a lost and dying world with the truth. Please continue to remember us in your prayers as we "sow the seed" and pray that it will land on honest and good hearts. Especially pray for the efforts coming up in Louisville.
